

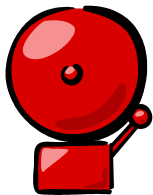
29.5 Road Bridge Replacement

Building Bridges

As a joint effort between Mesa County and Mountain Valley Contracting, road work on 29.5 Road, between Orchard Avenue and Patterson Roads, will commence in January 2017 to provide a wider built bridge over the Grand Valley Irrigation Canal in your area.

We are looking forward to a clean project and being done quickly to reduce the amount of inconvenience to the local traffic. Due to concerns for the safety of the students who use this corridor while walking to the nearby Bookcliff Middle School, we have chosen to delay the closure of the roadway and bridge demolition until after the beginning of the winter break for the students.

Please be aware that this is heavy road construction and is a dangerous area for all non-authorized personnel. We strongly advise all pedestrians and their families to find alternate routes around the area as depicted by the detour signs that will be installed. Accommodations will be made for those that live directly in the construction zone

01/03-01/13	Bridge Deck and Abutment Removals
01/16-01/25	Excavate for and Install New Bridge Piling
01/26-02/22	Form and Pour New Abutments
02/23-03/15	New Canal Lining Installed Under Bridge
03/31-04/30	Install New Bridge Deck and Repave Road
05/01-05/11	Final Cleanup and Project Completion
